THE PERFECT CORNERSTONE AND FOUNDATION

The Sand Palace is a beautiful home built on the shore in Mexico Beach, Florida. On October 10, 2018, Hurricane Michael, a category 5 hurricane with winds reaching 160 mph, tore through and destroyed the Florida Panhandle. Mexico Beach was one of the hardest-hit areas, where homes and businesses were decimated, leaving nothing but bare foundations. However, the Sand Palace was largely untouched, standing tall on its stilts above the carnage and destruction all around. Everyone wanted to know why this home survived in such pristine condition.

The homeowners of the Sand Palace were wise enough to build their home to withstand 240 to 250 mph winds, despite Florida's state code that requires houses to be built to withstand 120 mph winds. Instead of 30-foot pilings, the Sand Palace was built with 40-foot pilings made of poured concrete walls with rebar and steel cables. Why? One owner explained:

At every point, from pilings to the roof and everything in between, when it came time to make a decision about what level of material or what to use, we didn't pay attention to code...We went above and beyond code, and we

asked the question: "What would survive the big one?" And we consistently tried to build it for that.5

The Sand Palace is a perfect analogy for Matthew 7:24–27:

Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.

Perhaps there's something from both stories that we can take on our parenting journeys.

IT STARTS BEFORE BIRTH

Praying for your child should begin even before conception and continue during pregnancy. The perinatal nurse who oversees the Nurturing Your Newborn ministry at a church I attended repeatedly encourages the young mothers in her classes to pray out loud for their babies every single day, not only for the mental and physical health of both mother and infant, but also for the faith that child will grow to have. As a nurse and the mother of two God-loving young adults, she could testify about the importance of laying the foundation of faith even before that precious child is born.

God's Word tells us, "You desired faithfulness even in the womb; you taught me wisdom in that secret place" (Psalm 51:6). God told the prophet Jeremiah, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart" (Jeremiah 1:5). The prophet Isaiah said, "The LORD called me from the womb" (Isaiah 49:1 ESV). King David, the man after God's own heart, acknowledged God from birth. (See 1 Samuel 13:14; Psalm 22:9). Timothy knew the Scriptures from the time he was an infant. (See 2 Timothy 3:15.)

The Lord was the anchor and hope for these amazing men's souls from the beginning, keeping them from drifting away. "We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure" (Hebrews 6:19).

Children need a sturdy anchor, a solid foundation of truth, and the knowledge that these tools will keep them secure from turbulent winds and storms in times of trouble. The largest tree will fall if its roots (its anchors) are not deep enough to support it. Helical piles are deep-foundation elements (anchors) used to support buildings. The sturdiness and strength of a structure are only as solid as the foundation it rests upon. Shirley K. Morgenthaler says:

Stone by stone, we set the foundation for the expectations of living—the traditions and values...The foundation must be laid before the walls or floors can be added...God has been the perfect Architect. His design has been flawless... the important is always worth doing, right from the start... Without that anchor, the unknown can be dreaded and feared. With the Holy Spirit as our mooring and foundation, the future is welcomed no matter what it holds.⁶

PREPARING THE FOUNDATION

My friend Chris's dad loved to garden. From the time his grandkids were toddlers, he taught them how to grow nutritious food to eat or beautiful flowers to touch and smell by planting seeds in the right soil. Chris says her two children delighted in helping Grandpa till and fertilize the ground, plant the seeds, water the garden, and eventually pick the vegetables and flowers.

Spiritually, the process is much the same. Preparing the soil from the time children are in the womb to three years of age—is the first step in building a solid foundation to support their spiritual life. Without preparation, the foundation could become weak, giving the world a chance to dismantle or destroy what has been constructed.

Even if this spiritual work begins after the child's third birthday, the foundation can still be built upon good soil. Honestly, I wish I had discovered and applied many of the things that I learned in my research as I was raising my children. I did my best with what I knew, and God was faithful to call my children to Him. I thank God that He can restore whatever has been lost, as it's never too late to start transforming their hearts and minds. "I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten—the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm—my great army that I sent among you" (Joel 2:25).

If you didn't start early with your children, please don't feel guilty. How can you be guilty of not doing something you didn't know? God is able to bless your faithfulness whenever you obey what you have learned.

Nothing can prepare children for life lessons more effectively than the Word of God. I remember reading the story about Mack, a first-time father who took this truth to heart. As he was preparing the nursery for his unborn son, he wrote passages of Scripture on the walls before he painted them hunter green. These words

of God's wisdom, love, and truth will surround Mack's son as he grows.

Just as the Sand Palace was built to withstand destructive elements, we want to raise our children to withstand the evil intentions of Satan, who comes only "to steal and kill and destroy" (John 10:10). We do this by adhering to the Word of God and seeking the guidance of His Holy Spirit.
